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All UWC colleges are registered charities that depend on private sponsors/donors to enable access by students from a wide spectrum of economic backgrounds. Students are selected against specific performance criteria and evaluated on merit regardless of religious, social or ethnic background.

The cost for a UWC education varies between the different colleges and is subject to the prevailing exchange rates. As an indication, the **full fee paying** cost for the two years at college may be as much as RM500,000. Most places are offered on a full fee paying basis. Some places may be offered on a partial scholarship basis that is usually between 10% and 50%. Full scholarships are only very occasionally offered – when they are offered, stringent criteria are applied to ensure that only truly deserving candidates from financially disadvantaged backgrounds are selected.

Full and high partial scholarships are reserved for meritorious applicants from financially disadvantaged backgrounds. Applicants from private and international schools cannot be considered for full or high partial scholarships, unless there are extenuating circumstances.

Whilst the Malaysia National Committee and the Colleges would wish to be in the position to offer all selected students full scholarships, the reality is that scholarships and/or places are awarded by a combination of means, merit, offers from the colleges and the resources of UWC charitable organisations. This means that education in a UWC may require parental contributions, which sometimes can be substantial. If you can afford to make a partial or full contribution to your UWC education, you are advised to indicate as such below. The individual colleges and the Malaysia National Committee will conduct a financial assessment to establish demonstrated need.

- **United World College Dilijan** – two (2) Partial Scholarship places.
  - Family contribution – **a minimum of USD 25,000 per annum** for the two year programme. This fee covers tuition, accommodation and food costs during term time.

- **Li Po Chun United World College, Hong Kong** – one (1) Partial Scholarship place

- 3) The cost for a UWC education varies between the different colleges and is subject to the prevailing exchange rates. As an indication, the **full fee paying** cost for the two years at college may be as much as RM500,000. Places offered on a partial scholarship basis are usually between 10% - 50%. Full scholarships are only very occasionally offered – when they are offered, stringent criteria are applied to ensure that only truly deserving candidates from financially disadvantaged backgrounds are selected.
